3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the window at the south side of the clubhouse, visible from the outside.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole on the sea side of the club.

9 THE COURSES

Trapezoid or Windward Leeward courses will be used. The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

10 MARKS

Marks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be Yellow Inflatables. The start mark will be a Green Inflatable. The finish mark will be a red Inflatable.
