## SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

*The notation [NP] in a rule of the sailing instructions means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).*

### 1. Communications with competitors

- 1.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official noticeboard linked from the NYC and ILCA websites (<https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/documents/9320/event>)

### 2. Signals made ashore

- 2.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from a flagpole at NYC

### 3. Courses

- 3.1. Trapezoid courses will be used as per Attachment 1
- 3.2. If only one gate mark is laid it will be taken as a leeward mark and rounded to Port.

### 4. Marks

- 4.1. Marks 1, 2, 3, 4s, 4p and 5 will be yellow inflatables. The start mark, if used, shall be a dan buoy with an orange flag. The finish mark will be a dan buoy with a blue flag.
- 4.2. A race committee vessel signalling a change to a leg of the course is a mark as provided in SSI 6.1

### 5. The Start

- 5.1. The starting line will be between a mast displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal vessel at the starboard end and either a starting mark or the orange flag on a RIB at the port end of the line.

- 5.2. [DP] A buoy may be attached to the race committee starting vessel. Boats shall not pass between this buoy and the race committee starting vessel at any time

## 6. Change of the next leg of the course

- 6.1. Except at a gate, boats shall pass between the race committee vessel signalling the change of the next leg and the nearby mark, leaving the mark to port and the race committee vessel to starboard. This changes RRS 28

## 7. Hearing Requests

- 7.1. Hearing Requests shall be lodged using the online portal (<https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/documents/9320/event>)
- 7.2. Hearings will be held in the Granard Room in the NYC

## 8. Official Vessels

- 8.1. Committee boat: Christo – Blue sailing cruiser.
- 8.2. Finish boat: Jascah – White sailing cruiser.
- 8.3. The race committee may substitute or alter these boats if necessary. Such change shall not be grounds for protest or request for redress.
- 8.4. Official vessels will be marked as follows:

Vessel	Flag
Race Committee Vessels	NYC Burgee
Jury Vessels	YELLOW flag
Rescue / First Aid / Safety	WHITE flag with RED numbers
Registered support vessels	GREEN flag with WHITE numbers

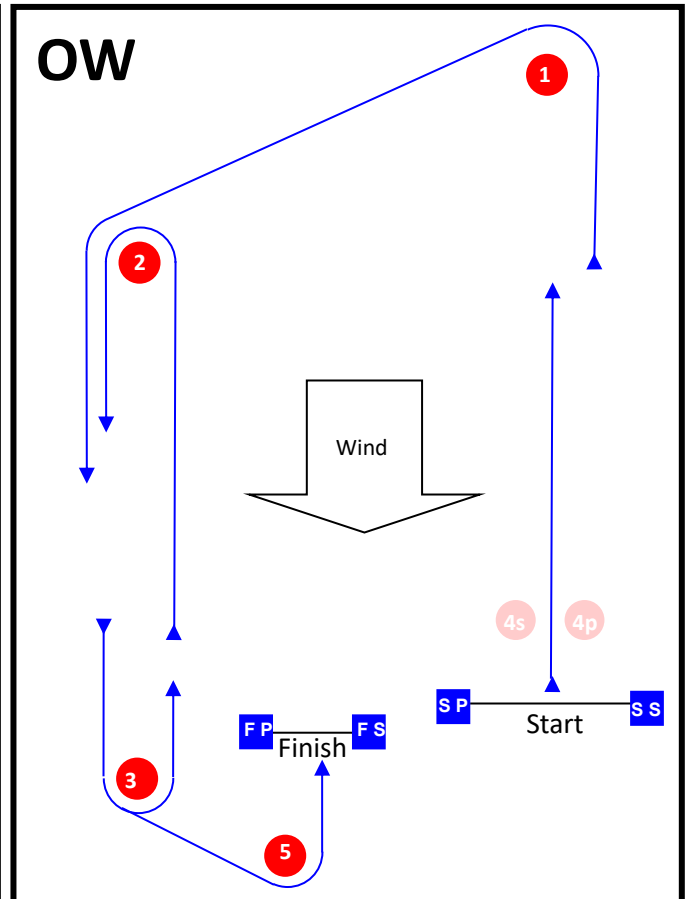
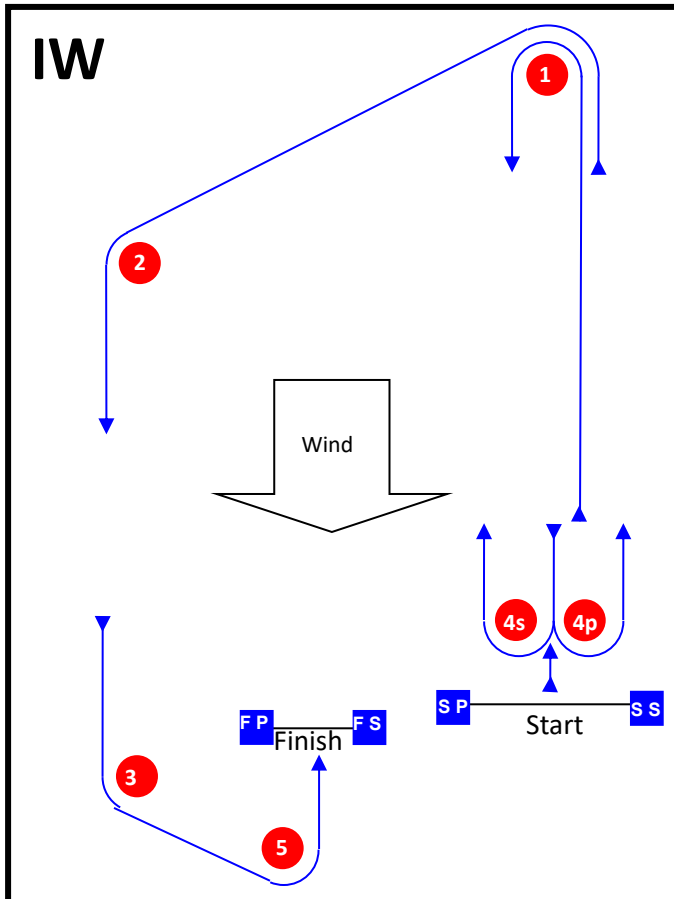
## 9. General

- 9.1. CRUISE SHIPS are expected to be at anchor in the Bay, to the east of the sailing area. They typically operate a programme of shuttle tenders for passengers between the ship and Harbour Berth 4. A shuttle will be preceded by a guard boat flying a flag. **NOTE that all ILCA related boats MUST not impede these shuttle boats by passing ahead**
- 9.2. Competitors are granted temporary membership of the National Yacht Club for the duration of the event.

<b>IW1</b>	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
<b>IW2</b>	Start – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
<b>IW3</b>	Start – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
<b>IW4</b>	Start – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 4s/4p – 1 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish

**Course: Outer Trapezoid with beat to finish**

Signal	Mark Rounding Order
<b>OW2</b>	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
<b>OW3</b>	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
<b>OW4</b>	Start – 1 – 2 – 3s/3p – 2 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 2 – 3 – 5 – Finish
