SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

1 RULES

- 1.1 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) are to be read in conjunction with the current ILCA Major Event Sailing Instructions ([MESIs](#)). If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race or MESI and these SSIs, these SSIs shall prevail.

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1 The official notice board is online at [ILCA Leinsters 2025 Online Notice Board](#).
- 2.2 The race office is located in the Granard room, National YC lower floor, telephone 087 629 1568 (Sandra Moore), email sailing@nyc.ie.
- 2.3 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate on VHF radio channel 69.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the Yardarm on the forecourt of the National YC.

4 RACING AREA

- 4.1 The racing area is on the south side of Dublin Bay.

5 MARKS

- 5.1 The course marks 1, 3S, 3P, 4S, 4P will be yellow inflatable cylindrical marks. Course mark 2 will be a yellow inflatable cylindrical mark with a white band. Mark 1A will be an small orange inflatable mark.

6 OBSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 All boats are prohibited from entering the following NO GO areas:
- (a) Dublin Port Channel
 - (b) Bathing Areas: at Dun Laoghaire Baths, Sandycove/40FT and Seapoint marked by small yellow conical buoys. No boat shall sail inside these buoys.
- 6.2 [DP] [NP] Cruise ship tenders and small passenger ferries etc have priority over all other boats in Dun Laoghaire Harbour and the fairway that extend 600 metres seaward of the harbour mouth. It is incumbent upon each individual competitor and support vessel to ensure early and sufficient action is taken to present a free and unhindered passage to power-driven vessels.

7 THE START

- 7.1 The starting line will be between the main mast on a committee vessel displaying an orange flag at the starboard end and the start mark or a staff displaying an orange flag on a rib.

8 HEARING REQUESTS

- 8.1 Hearing Request shall be submitted using the online system [here](#).
- 8.2 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held on the lower floor of NYC.

9 OFFICIAL VESSELS

- 9.1 Official vessels, other than those listed below, will carry either NYC burgees or a white flag with red numbers. Jury boats will carry a yellow flag.

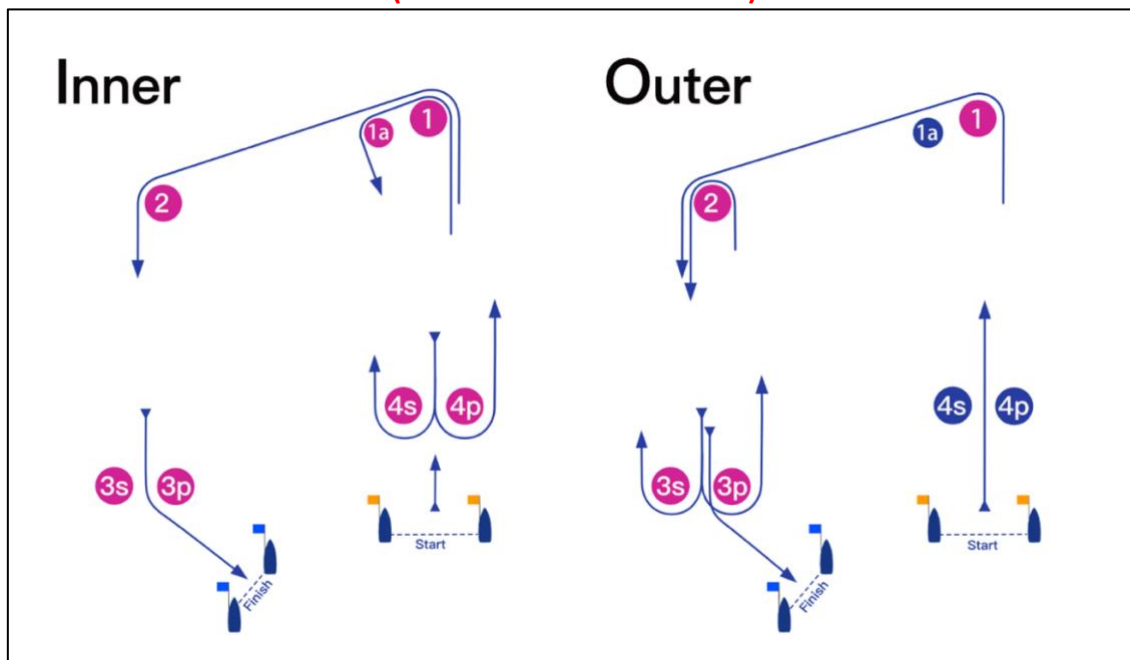
Committee Vessel	Terra Nova	40' Yacht

10 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS

- 10.1 Support person vessels shall be identified with white flags with black numbers.

Regatta officials are using a web-based program to assist with the management of this regatta. It provides electronic forms for such actions as scoring inquiries, protests, equipment substitutions, etc. And it provides for electronic communication with competitors if competitors have provided an email and/or telephone number accepting SMS. Competitors will be notified electronically of protest time limits, confirmation of a protest filing, scheduled hearing times, etc. This electronic system allows competitors to move freely about the event and remain in contact with relevant officials. And all competitors have electronic access to the scoring inquiries, jury decisions, etc.*
